First		Rector's Announcement No. 2/2017 Prohibition of the use of certain electronic devices during attestation

Art. I Introductory provision

This measure specifies the range of devices and equipment that cannot be used in the assessment of students' knowledge during examination dates (credit, examination, final state examination) at AMBIS University, a.s. (hereinafter referred as "AMBIS"), regardless of their form.

Art. II Prohibition of electronic devices

- (1) The use of any electronic device that allows remote communication, remote access and/or data storage is prohibited in all types of subject completion at AMBIS, i.e. in credits or examinations. The same prohibition is applied during state final examinations.
- (2) For this Measure, the electronic devices referred to in paragraph (1) shall mean in particular mobile phones, tablets, laptops, cameras, cameras, smart watches, headphones, etc.
- (3) It is also forbidden to make any recording in any way of the examination tests or other forms of subject completion (e.g. audio or video recording, photographs, screen prints).
- (4) It is also forbidden to store test data or test results in a manner other than that specified in the test specification (e.g. in proprietary devices that allow such storage).
- (5) Depending on the nature and method of completion of the subject, the tutor may decide to allow a specific aid or electronic device that is necessary for the completion of the subject (e.g calculator, PC in the examination room, etc.).
- (6) Violation of the prohibition on the use of the above electronic devices will be grounds for immediate termination of the test date and a subject completion grade of "4 fail" in the case of an exam or "N" in the case of credit. It may also be grounds for initiating disciplinary action against the student.
